ANATOMY OF AN ITEM RECORD

Item Type:

- Does not display to the public
- Used to determine how the item circulates
- Doesn't need to have any correlation to the item's format
- Not used for Statistics

• Home Location:

- Displays to the public
- Used to assist patrons in finding the item in your library
- Sometimes used by libraries for statistics

Item Categories:

- Some display to the public
- Used by patrons to facet/limit catalog searches
- Describe the item
- Used as primary criteria for Statistics
- o ICat1:
 - Broad Format of material
- O ICat2:
 - Intended Audience: Adult, Teen/YA, Children
- o ICat3:
 - Fiction or NonFiction
 - Best guess—some things like realia or music CDs are UNKNOWN
- O ICat4:
 - Indicates whether the item circulates according to State definition of "Circulation"
 - Required for State statistics

• Class Scheme:

- Should always be DEWEY, or ASIS for Magazines
- AUTO causes the Call Num to become ALL-CAPS

• Call number:

- Varies slightly by library, but the more the same the better
 - Standardization helps the patron in the catalog
 - Standardization helps the patron find the item on the shelf
 - It is difficult if not impossible to sort lists if the call number fields aren't entered systematically. Spacing and Capitalization make a difference in how things sort
 - Easier for WCTS: Imagine needing to remember 19 different
- o Magazine Call Numbers NEED to be standardized. See Handout.
- o If we ever hope to get to a point where patrons can put a hold on the 3rd volume of a graphic or May issue of a magazine and get the first copy from any library, we need to start using the same terminology.
- It is our recommendation that libraries NOT put J, +, E, Ref, etc. in the call number field in front of the Dewey
 or other call number. Use the Home Location field to indicate the collection for the item.
 - For libraries using BISAC, or non-Dewey call numbers, the collection name may go in square brackets in front of the rest of the call number.

• Price:

- The system uses this price when billing the patron for a lost item
- If left blank the system will use a default price which in no way reflects reality
