

Decoding Unfilled Replies

Information for decoding unfilled replies is always available on the ILL page of the extranet. (<https://extranet.winnefox.org/ill>)

Sample unfilled reply
50 TEFMT; 13 EYP; 41 TWE JBZ; 36 STD; 5 MJ1; no other owning locs

The numbers are the most important party. They represent the reason the item isn't filled. <http://extranet.winnefox.org/illcodes>

Decoded unfilled reasons
50 = not accessible
13 = library charges to lend
41 = lender does not loan this format
5 = not owned
36 = location is currently not accessible - they are usually an OCLC lender but are not lending at this item. There is no information available as to when or if they

The letters represent the specific OCLC library. <http://www.oclc.org/en/contacts/libraries.html>

Decoded library names
TEFMT = Midwest Tape (this is actually a bookseller/distributor not a library)
EYP = Detroit Public Library
TWE = Norfolk Public Library
JBZ = Palatine Public Library
STD = Stowe-Monroe Public Library
MJ1 = Newman Region Library District
