Past Approaches to Public Workforce Development Programming

Supporting the economy by investing in workforce is something the U.S. government has done since the Morrill Act of 1862, which funded agricultural and mechanic schools.

Federal agencies continued to support the workforce development system, often by **specializing** in customers and activities.



A System-Approach to Public Workforce Development

In 2014, Congress passed a federal law, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), with broad bipartisan support.

This legislation required that all government-funded workforce programs **work together as one system** to serve **common customers.**



No Wrong Door

WIOA ushered in the concept of "No Wrong Door" to access federally-funded employment and training programs through coordinated workforce systems.
