


follow / unfollow

p.s. when you unfollow, nobody gets notified

















Why create a Pinterest account?




Why create an account for your library?

 ✓ video tutorials for OverDrive, BadgerLink
- ✓ YouTube videos, Flickr photos
- \checkmark items for sale in the Friends bookstore
- √ digitized collections of local history photos

How to convert a personal account

We want to help your business get the most out of Pinterest.

- 1. click on "Convert your existing account"
- log in to your existing personal account
- 3. follow the steps to complete the process

Note: once you convert your personal account to a business account, you will not be able to revert back to a personal account.


On the results page...
