Fizzy Sidewalk Paints

Mix:

- 1 LB. box of baking soda
- ½ cup corn starch

Carefully add:

• 1 cup very warm water

Stir in the water. You may want to add a little more/less to the best texture possible. You will want it to be a bit runny like paint.

Divide the paint into three bowls or cups and add some food coloring to get different colors.

Pour vinegar into a spray bottle.

Paint sidewalks with paint, spray with bottle.

Alka Seltzer Lava Lamps

Fill a Bottle:

- 2/3 full with oil
- Add water until the bottle only has 1-2 inches of air space left at the top.

Carefully add:

- 5 drops of food coloring
- Alka Seltzer ¼ tablet at a time When the bubbles slow down, add more.

Baking Soda Invisible Ink

- ¼ Cup baking soda
- ¼ cup water

Write using a Q-tip. Let dry completely. Once dry, paint with grape juice concentrate.

Milk/Lemon Juice Invisible Ink

- Milk/ Lemon Juice (Can also try vinegar, apple juice)
- Heat Source Iron, 100 watt light bulb

Write with milk, allow to dry, heat.

Slime Recipe

- Elmer's Glue
- Food Coloring
- Water

- Borax Powder
- 2 small plastic cups

Fill one small cup with water and add a spoonful of the Borax powder, stir and set aside. Fill the other small cup with about 1 inch of the glue. Add three tablespoons of water to the glue and stir. Add food coloring. Now add one tablespoon of the borax solution to the glue/water and stir. Starts out wet but then gets harder.
