Number _____

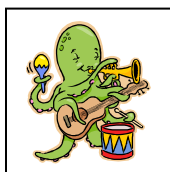
Find books that are enjoyable and age-appropriate. Check out the action, suspense, and fast-paced books. Guide children to help them choose books they would like to read.

Number _____

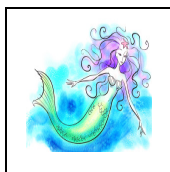
The real test of a "good" book is the reaction of the child to it. Check this collection for high interest books. "True" books about animals, science, hobbies, art, music, & more!
