Copy and paste or import EPUB, Word, Open Office, or URL

Organize sections, add metadata, apply themes, create covers,

Export to PDF, EPUB, MOBI (for Kindle), and more

Publish to SELF-e, ebook stores or print on demand services; add “buy” links

Add users to your account as editors or contributors

Customize sharing and privacy settings

New or established authors of novels, poetry, local history, genealogy

Open educational resources: textbooks, course packs, lessons

Internal organizational documents: archives of minutes, newsletters

Pros

- Simple, streamlined and easier to use
- Sign into multiple libraries using different cards
- Download for offline use
- More customizable view of collection
- Holds have expected wait time (also a con!)

Cons

- Not compatible with Kindle tablets or videos
- No recommend titles option
- Not able to create wishlists
- No sharing titles



AUTOMATICALLY DOWNLOAD?

Everything

All borrowed titles will be added to the download queue automatically.



Titles under 20 megabytes

Most books are under 20mb, but audiobooks are often in excess of 300mb, and graphic novels are typically over 100mb. To manually download an excluded title, tap the cloud icon on the shelf.



Nothing

Each title will stream, and will be unavailable offline, unless you choose to download it manually.



DOWNLOAD ONLY ON WI-FI

Reduces mobile data usage.

Here you can change the default settings of new holds.

SEND HOLD NOTICES TO

For new holds, you will receive a courtesy email to this address when the hold is ready to borrow. If you are under 13 years old, enter the email address of your parent or guardian.

BORROW HOLDS AUTOMATICALLY

When a hold becomes available, it will be borrowed for you automatically, as long as you are not at your loans limit for that library card.

HOLD STATE

Active

You can suspend holds when you have too much to read, or too little time. Your hold will progress while suspended. Other people move ahead of you only when you're at the front of the queue.

All of your existing holds have these settings.

Active

- Suspend for 1 week
- Suspend for 2 weeks
- Suspend for 3 weeks
- Suspend for 4 weeks
- Suspend for two months
- Suspend for three months
- Suspend for six months
